How could you get involved?

Sharing stories:

This could be done through shadowing at the workplace or providing an inspirational workshop.

Breaking stereotypes:

By meeting successful women working in different roles and industries, the aim is to enhance understanding of the breadth of career opportunities available, challenge gendered stereotypes within occupations and give young women the chance to make connections with female role models.

Equity around gender and women in the workplace.

Business Principles:

Principles of motivational theory, business viability and marketing within their context. How to keep innovating in a competitive world.

Awareness of emerging careers:

Shadowing different people/teams e.g product development, innovation scrum, especially those with emerging job roles that might not have existed 5-10 years ago.
